

What does Tickets Please do?

Tickets Please assists disabled and disadvantaged people with travel costs so that they can:

- Visit children in hospitals far from home
- Visit close relatives who are in care, prison or rehabilitation
- Get specialist treatment far from home
- Attend important appointments

Who can apply?

Disabled or disadvantaged people living in the United Kingdom who need help with fares can apply.

What is the application procedure?

Applications can only be accepted from sponsors e.g. a health or social worker. See **Guidelines for Sponsors** for details. There is an application form inside this leaflet.

Guidelines for Sponsors:

Eligibility

Assistance from Tickets Please is intended only for those in greatest need of financial support and unable to get help from any other body. **(It's a one off grant)**

Individuals and families living anywhere in the UK are eligible.

Priority will be given to applications involving children and young people when funds are low.

Purpose

The journeys must have some therapeutic or rehabilitative value for either the person travelling or the person being visited.

Exclusions

Travel outside the UK; holidays; funeral expenses; medical equipment; wheelchairs/cars.

Applications

Applications must be made on this form and must enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope for a reply. Forms should be sent to the Tickets Please Administrator at the address on the back of this leaflet. Please restrict covering letters to one page.

NB: Tickets Please is funded entirely by grants & donations. At times this may mean there are no funds available.
